



Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account

Under the Federal Flexible Spending Account Program (FSAFEDS), a Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account (DCFSA) is a pre-tax benefit account used to pay for dependent care services, such as summer day camps, before and after school programs, nursery school, preschool, private sitters and child or elder daycare. With a DCFSA, you have an additional 2 ½ month grace period to incur eligible expenses and use the DCFSA funds remaining in your account.
